- For areas indicating the tightening torque in this instruction manual, tighten to the specified torque by using a torque wrench. For areas in which the tightening torque is indicated inside parentheses (), the tightening torque is indicated as a reference value, however tightening using a torque wrench is not necessary
- Do not modify the trailer hitch kit
- Do not install the trailer hitch kit in any way other than described in the following instructions.
- If in doubt, please contact your Mazda dealer to install the accessory in order to prevent errors in installation.
- If you have any questions about the use of the accessory, ask your Mazda dealer for proper advice before using it.
- Mazda and its suppliers are not responsible for injuries, accidents, and damage to persons and property that arise from the failure of the dealer or installer to follow these instructions.

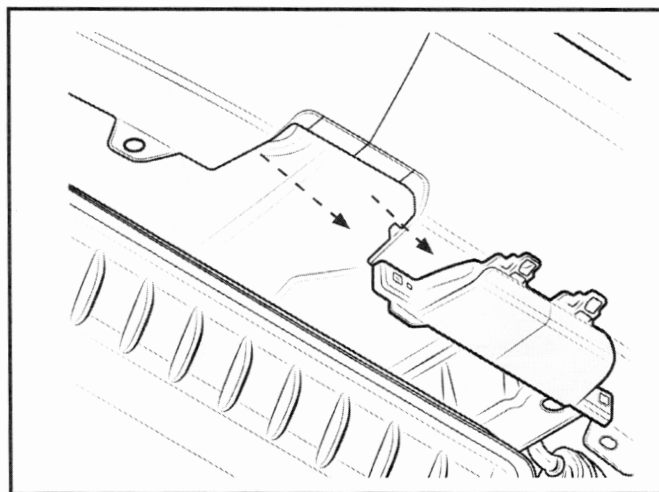
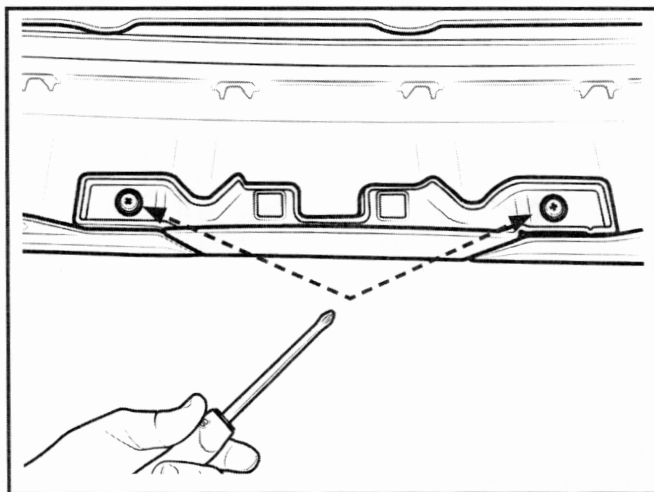
- A)** Read installation instructions before proceeding.
- B)** Do not damage paint or kit components.
- C)** Do not over tighten bolts. Tighten to specified torque.
- D)** Thoroughly clean installation areas.
- E)** Two persons are needed for some steps to be completed.

01**Remove Bumper Support****Tools Needed:**

- Remove four plastic fasteners on bumper support.
- Remove two screws on bumper support.
- Remove and discard bumper support and screws.
- Set plastic fasteners aside for reinstallation.

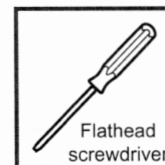
**02****Remove Bumper Cover****Tools Needed:**

- Remove two screws on bumper cover.
- Remove and discard bumper cover.



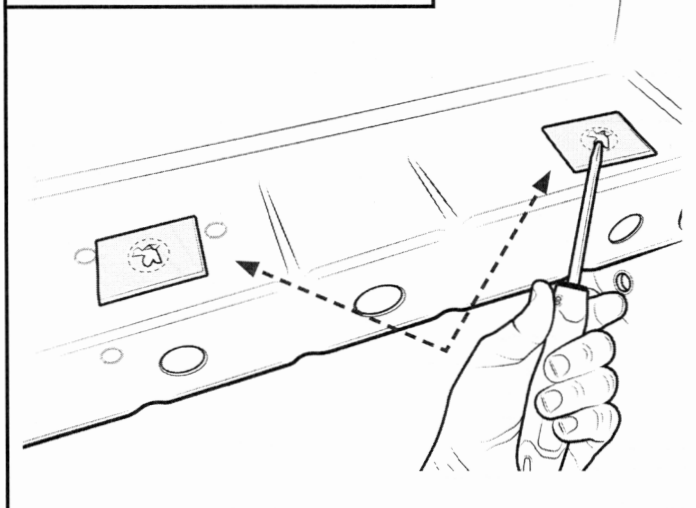
03 Driver and Passenger Side Frame Rail

Tools Needed:

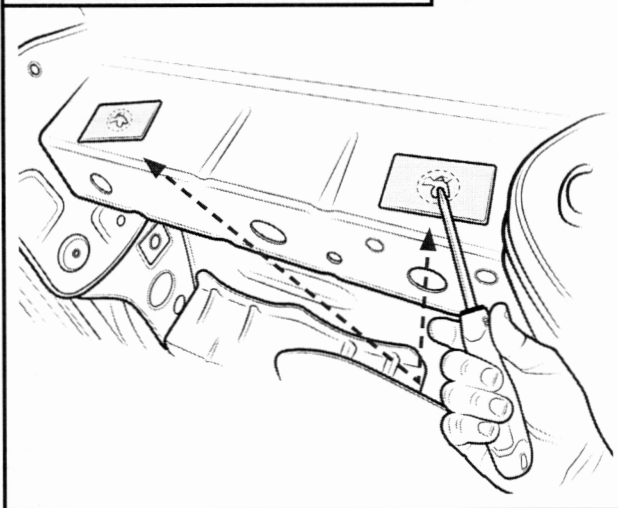


- Puncture and remove protective tape on outside of the driver and passenger side rail.

Driver side rail

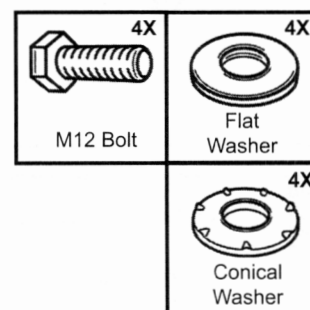


Passenger side rail



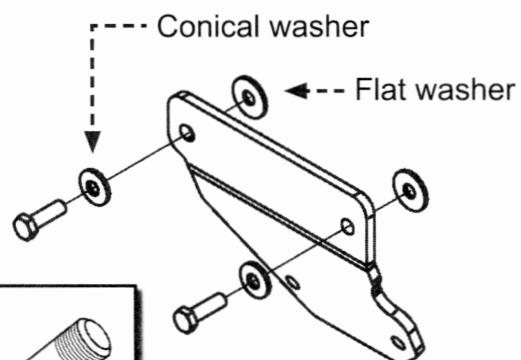
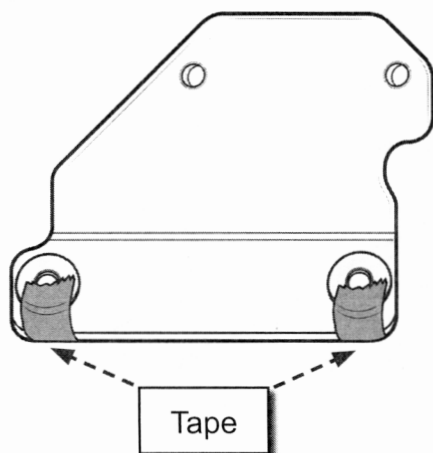
04 Driver Side Frame Rail

Tools Needed:



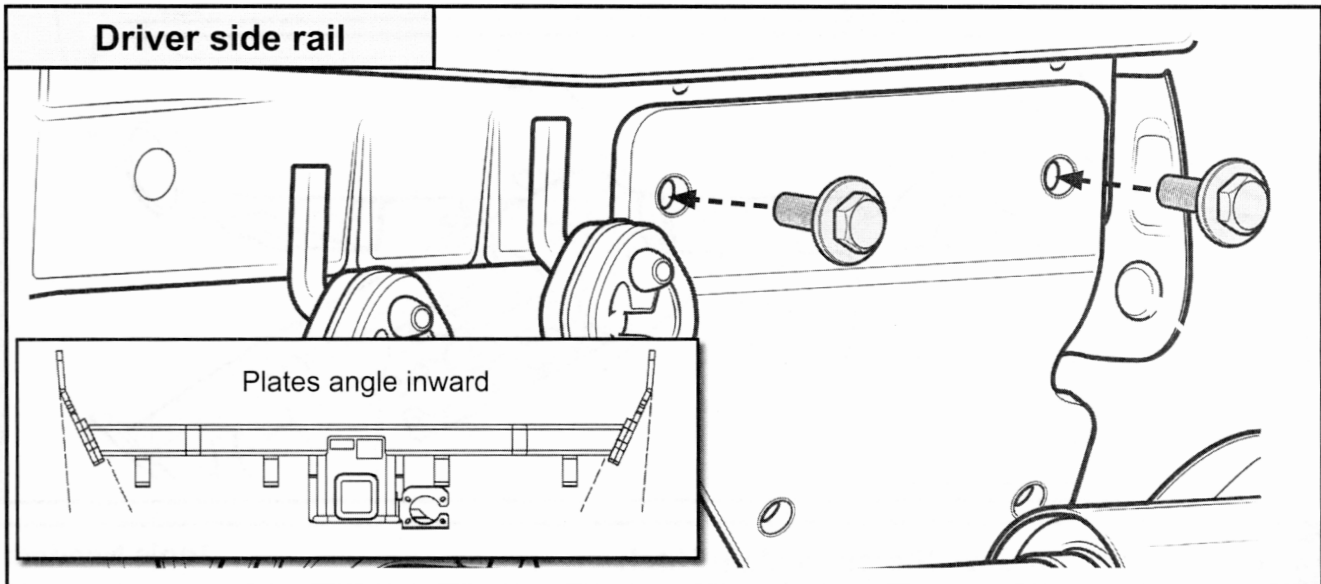
- A) Tape M12 flat washers to the inside of the side plates as shown in figure A.
- B) Note the hardware configuration of the side plates in figure B.
- **Note: Be sure teeth on conical washers are facing away from the bolt head.**

Trim excess mastic before installing side plates (if it will cause an interference with install.)



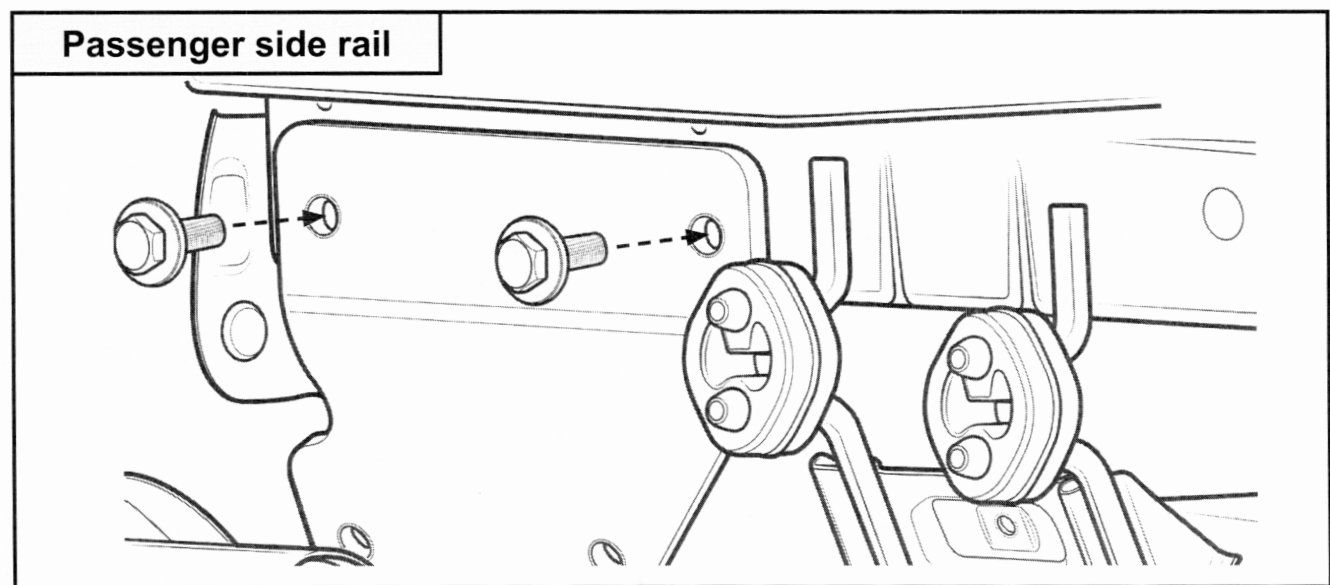
Loosely Bolt Drive Side Plate

- Position side plate onto driver side rail and use the M12 bolts, conical washers, and flat washers to assemble.
- **Note:** Be sure side plates are positioned so they angle towards the center of the vehicle.



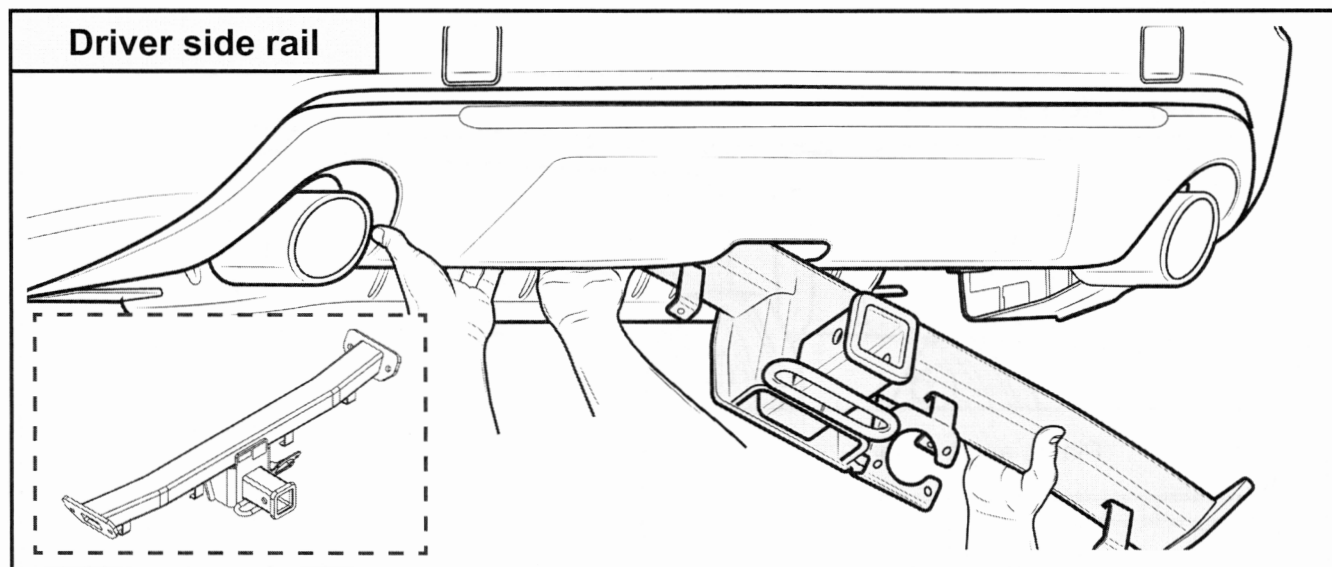
Loosely Bolt Passenger Side Plate

- Position the passenger side plate in the same configuration as stated above.
- **Note:** Be sure side plates are positioned so they angle towards the center of the vehicle.



05 Main Hitch Assembly (Two People Required)







- Person 1: Gently pull rear bumper fascia and metal fascia attachment brackets rearward to allow for main hitch insertion.
- Person 2: Insert main hitch into position.

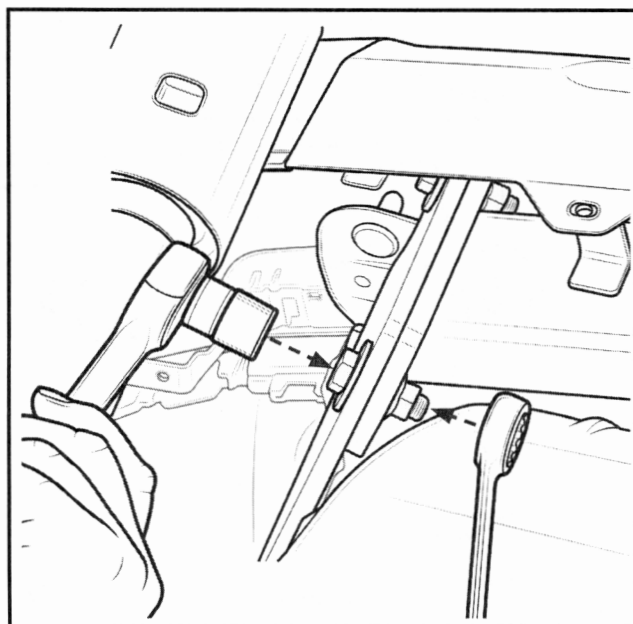
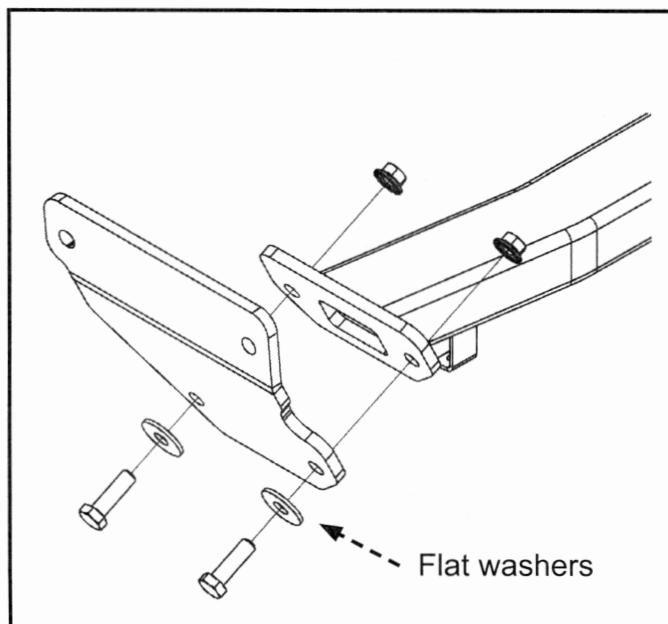


06 Loosely Attach Side Plates to Main Hitch

Tools Needed:

- Fasten side plates to main hitch using M12 bolts, flat washers, and M12 nuts (see figure A).
- **Note: Be sure serrations in nut are against main hitch plate.**

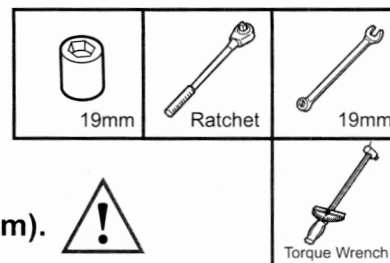

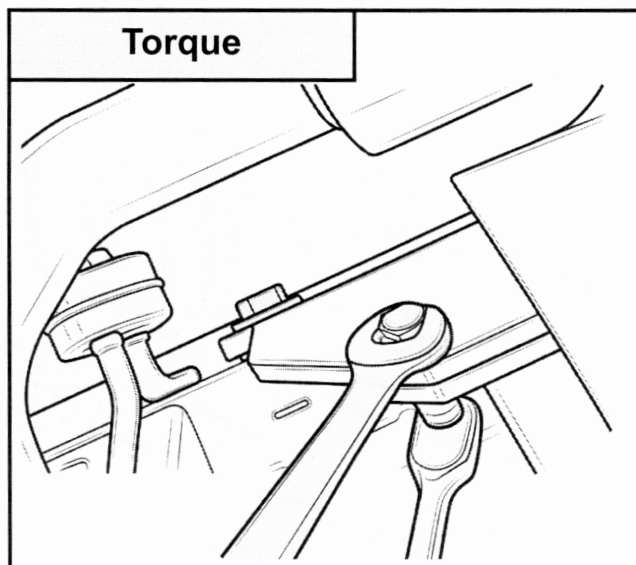
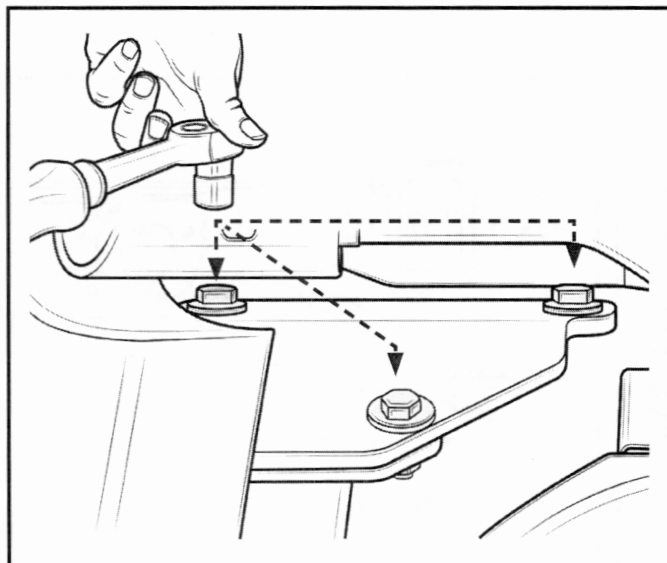
07 Torque Hardware

Tools Needed:

- Fully tighten side plates and bolts attaching side plates to main hitch and frame rail as shown.

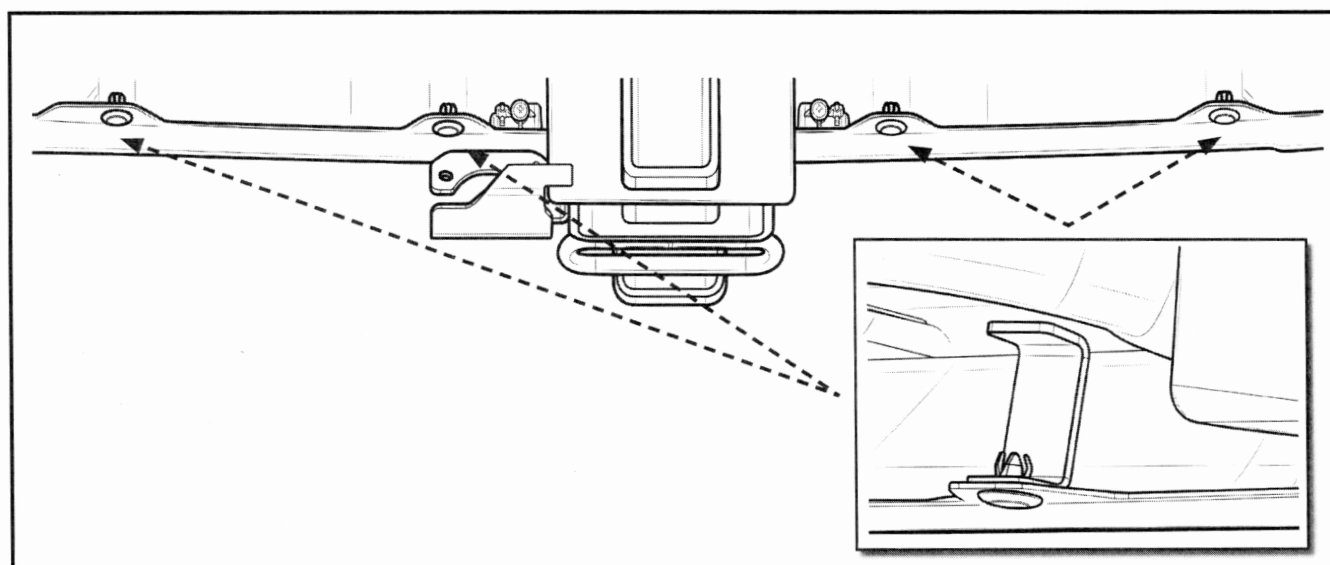


Torque all 8 bolts to 86.2 ft. lbs (116.9 Nm).



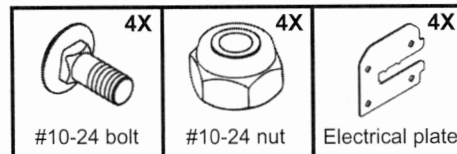
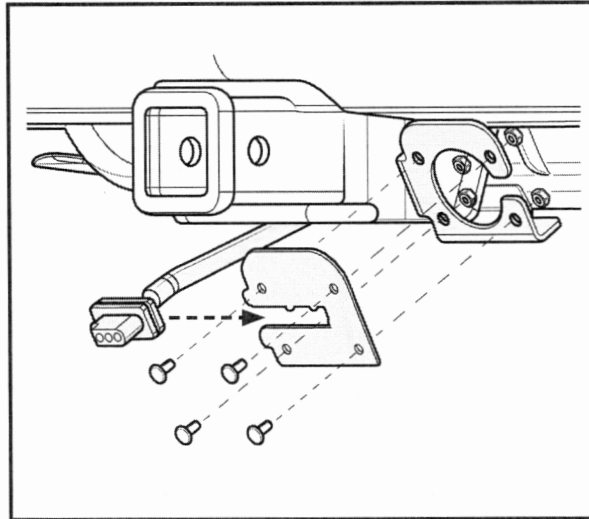
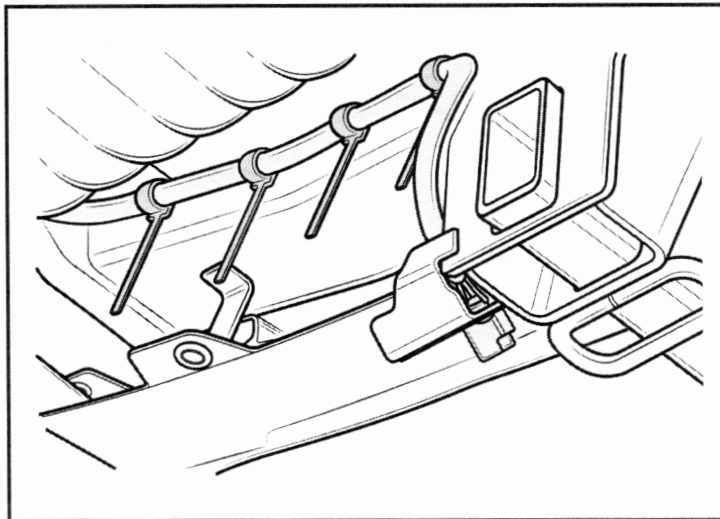
08 Reinstall Plastic Fasteners

- Align four hitch bumper support tab holes with fascia holes.
- Insert four plastic fastener(s) into bumper support tab and fascia holes.

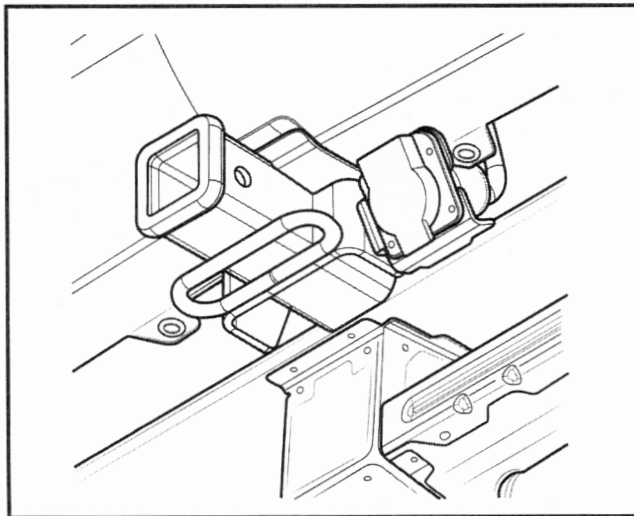
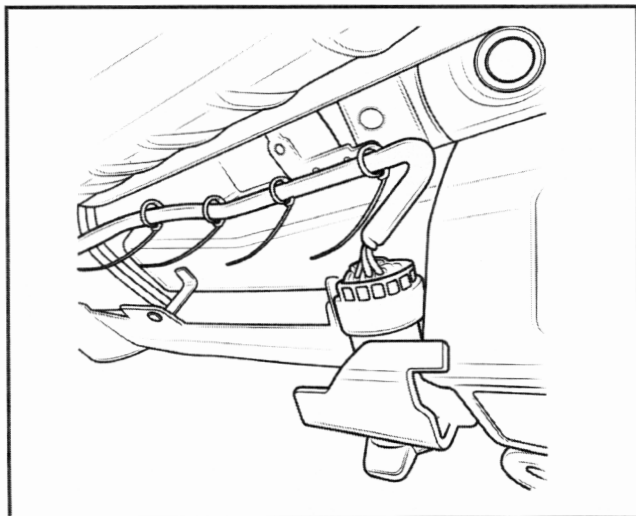


09**Attach 4-Pin Harness to Hitch (Non-Turbo Models Only)****Tools Needed:**

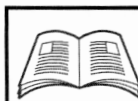
- Attach the harness with the four passenger side holes on back of main hitch. (See electrical instructions)
- Slide 4-pin connector into electrical plate.
- Bolt electrical plate to hitch bracket as shown below.

**Torque all four nuts to 19.5 ft. lbs (2.2 Nm).****10****Attach 7-Pin Harness to Hitch (Turbo Models Only)**

- Attach the harness to the hitch using the four holes in the main hitch on passenger side. (See electrical instructions)
- Bolt 7-pin harness to hitch bracket. (See electrical instructions)

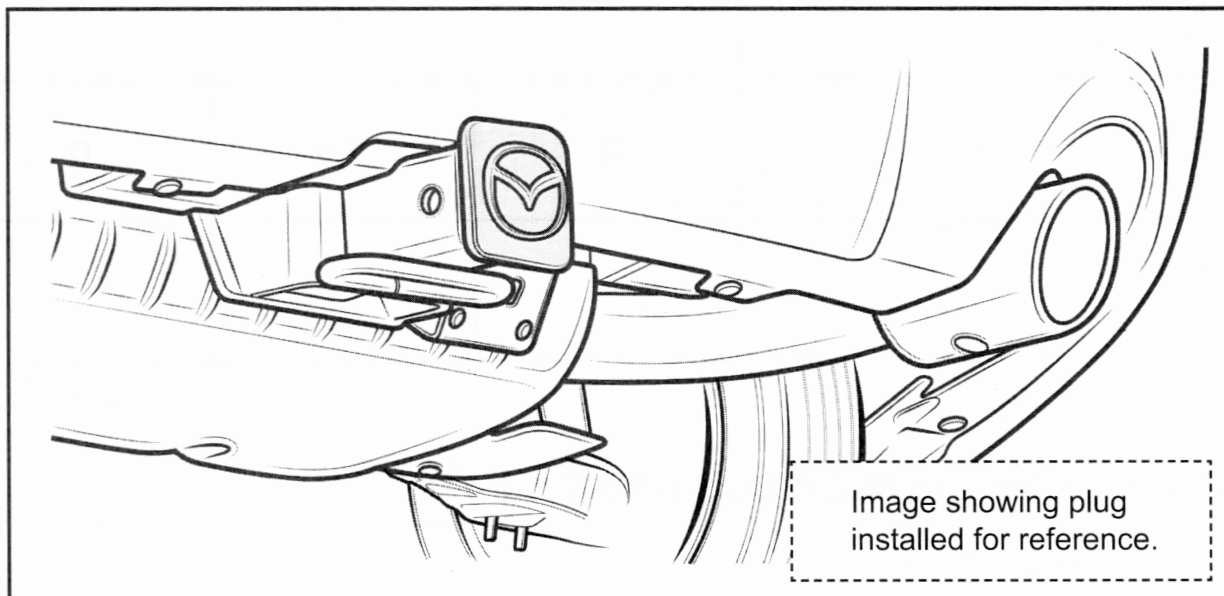


Hitch plug



Hitch pins

- Clean vehicle surface and debris.
- Reinstall trim clips under rear bumper fascia.
- Check torque on all bolts.
- Place user guide and hitch plug into the glove box.
